

New RDTHSC application route



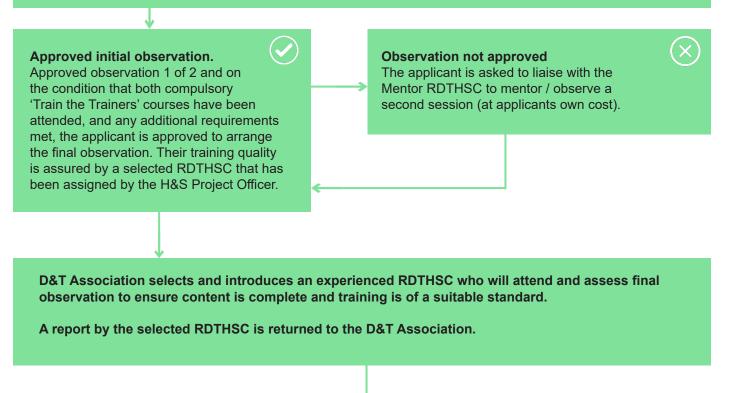
Mentor RDTHSC observes trainees' first training session

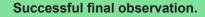
(Paying the RDTHSC to observe and complete forms is at the applicant's own cost). RDTHSC observes/guides applicant in the delivery of the session to help and assess competence and provide feedback.)

RDTHSC or applicant accredits the delegates, collects accreditation fees for training delivered, and adds details onto CUG.

(NB: if applicant adds details to CUG, these will not be processed until second observation has been completed to become fully registered, and so a delay is likely, however, this is an ideal opportunity to observe how the RDTHSC does this instead.)

Observation Form and Course Components Sheets are completed by mentoring RDTHSC and sent to D&T Association.





Applicant will be contacted for confirmation on RDTHSC status with certificate being sent shortly thereafter.

D&T Association membership converted to RDTHSC membership.

Unsuccessful final observation.

Applicant will be required to be observed a second time funded by themselves.

After 12 months of training, a quality assurance visit is arranged by D&T Association for a sample of active new RDTHSC's.
